### Equipment needed:

Large world map Post-it notes Pens

Optional: Newspapers Photographs from magazines Inflatable globes.

## Prayer Spaces in Schools

## This activity encourages pupils to pray for areas and issues in the world.

#### Instructions:

This activity encourages pupils to think about things that are happening around the world; perhaps things they've seen or heard about in the news, or about family or friends who live in different countries who they don't often get to see.

Display the world map, either on the floor or securely fixed to a wall, along with any newspapers or other information that you have collected, and some Post-it notes and pens. This is a great place to display information about any international charities which the school supports, partner schools in other countries or other overseas links that the pupils may have.

Encourage pupils to write or draw their thoughts or prayers on the Post-it notes and stick them on or near the country.
